On June 19, 2003, various irrigation entities, to wit: Pioneer Irrigation District and Settlers Irrigation District, by and through their counsel of record Moffatt, Thomas, Barrett, Rock & Fields, Chtd.; Nampa Meridian Irrigation District, New Dry Creek Ditch Company, Boise Valley Irrigation District Company South Boise Water Company, Eureka Water Company, Thurman Mill Ditch Company, Eagle Island Water Users Association, Farmers Cooperative Ditch Company and Ballantyne Ditch Company Limited, by and through their counsel of record Ringert Clark Chartered; and Farmers Union Ditch Company, Canyon County Water Company, Middleton Irrigation Association, and Middleton Mill Ditch Company, by and through their counsel of record Stoppello & Kiser, Attorneys at Law; (collectively "Irrigation Entities"), jointly filed a *Motion to Consolidate* a common issue regarding the ownership of water rights developed pursuant to the Reclamation Act of 1902 as between the Irrigation Entities and the United states Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, (BOR), specifically pertaining to water rights for Arrowrock Dam and Reservoir, Lucky Peak Dam and Reservoir and Anderson Ranch Dam and Reservoir.

The ownership issue was raised in subcases presently pending before Special Master Thomas Cushman. Because the ownership issue primarily involves a question of law, the likelihood of similar issues arising in other sub-basins, and the need to have the issue decided in an expeditious manner, the Court intends to preside over and decide the issue directly as opposed to having the matter first proceed before a special master.

THEREFORE, THE FOLLOWING ARE HEREBY ORDERED:

1. **Order Separating and Consolidating Issue**: Pursuant to *A01* § 11 and I.R.C.P. 42, IT IS ORDERED that the common issue regarding the ownership of water rights as between the Irrigation Entities and the BOR is separated from those subcases listed in attached **Exhibit A** and is consolidated into a single subcase for purposes of resolution.

Order Designating Issue as Consolidated Subcase 91-63: IT IS FURTHER
ORDERED that the consolidated subcase is hereby designated as consolidated subcase 91-63.
All future filings pertaining to said consolidated issue should be filed under said subcase number.

3. Order Rescinding Consolidated Issue from Order of Reference: IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ownership issue separated from those subcases listed in Exhibit A and now consolidated into consolidated subcase 91-63 is hereby rescinded from the previously issued

*Order of Reference to Special Master Thomas Cushman* which referred those subcases to Special master Cushman. Consolidated subcase 91-63 shall proceed before the Presiding Judge. All other matters and issues pertaining to said subcases in **Exhibit A** shall proceed before the Special Master. Any party asserting that issues regarding the other elements of the water rights cannot proceed until a resolution of the consolidated subcase is reached will have to take such matters up with the Special Master.

4. Notice of Initial Hearing for Scheduling and Status Purposes: Notice is hereby given that an initial hearing will be conducted for purposes of scheduling on July 15, 2003 at the SRBA Courthouse, 253 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. N., Twin Falls, Idaho. Anyone wishing to participate by phone may do so by calling 1-918-583-3445 and entering the participant code 406128 when prompted.

5. **Notices of Intent to Participate**: Any party to the adjudication not already a party to one of the enumerated subcases in **Exhibit A**, seeking to participate in the consolidated subcase may do so by filing and serving a response setting forth their position on the issue. The response must be served on the parties to the consolidated subcase (listed in the attached certificate of mailing) prior to the date set for the hearing.
