ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 14 ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE* IN THE SNAKE RIVER BASIN ADJUDICATION

This order establishes additional procedures for admission of attorneys *pro hac vice* in the Snake River Basin Adjudication (SRBA). This order is entered under the Presiding Judge's authority to effectively and expeditiously manage proceedings in this case and may be amended as needed. This order is intended to provide guidance for SRBA compliance with Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222.

1. Admission *pro hac vice* must be obtained from the Presiding Judge in each individual subcase in which the out-of-state attorney intends to appear, whether on behalf of a claimant, objector, or respondent.

2. Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222(j) requires that the applicant for limited admission submit a copy of the motion and a \$200 filing fee to the Idaho State Bar. In the SRBA, this requirement applies only to the first motion to appear filed in any given SRBA subcase and does not apply to motions to appear filed in subsequent subcases.

3. Service in any subcase in which an attorney is admitted *pro hac vice* shall be made on the designated local counsel. The SRBA court may send courtesy copies to other counsel provided such arrangements are made in advance with the clerk of the SRBA court.

4. The Special Master to whom a subcase is referred is authorized to excuse the attendance of the designated local counsel pursuant to Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222(e).

5. The Presiding Judge or Special Master may allow another attorney licensed in Idaho to personally appear in the stead of the designated local counsel. Provided, however, the

responsibilities and obligations applicable under Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222 shall apply to both the designated local counsel and the counsel appearing in his/her stead.

6. In any motion for admission *pro hac vice*, the out-of-state attorney shall certify to the SRBA Court that he/she is familiar with *SRBA Administrative Order 1, Rules of Procedure*, Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222, the Idaho Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Idaho Rules of Evidence. Further, the out-of-state attorney shall certify that he/she is in compliance with Idaho Bar Commission Rule 222(k).
