
#### POINTS OF DIVERSION

The points of diversion consist of 4 separate wells.

Three wells are located in a well field which is located in Township 53N Range 04W Section 06 SE1/4 of SE1/4 Government Lot 9 BM, County of Kootenai. Tax Assessor Parcel No. S00000069250

The fourth well is located in Township 53 N Range 04W Section 05 NE1/4SW1/4 County of Kootenai. Tax Assessor Parcel No. S600102005A

The physical location of the wells are shown on Exhibit "A" to this attachment



#### DESCRIPTION OF EXISTING DIVERSION WORKS

The diversion works consists of 4 wells, two storage tanks and a piped diversion system.

The depths and pumping capacity of the wells are as follows:

Well #1 is 359 ft. in depth 95 gpm
Well #2 is 389 feet in depth 150 gpm
Well #3 is 410 feet in depth 1300 gpm
Well #4 is 632 feet in depth 650 gpm

The storage system consists of a standpipe that has a total storage capacity of 236,100 gallons, with 136,000 of those gallons usable capacity. A second storage tank has usable capacity of 85,000. The total usable storage capacity between the two tanks is 221,000 gallons.

The water is distributed to the users within the service area from the wells and storage tanks through an underground water main line distribution system.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PLACE OF USE

The following is the Place of Use as defined by the Area of City Impact and the current city limits, and is subject to change based on amendments to the service area as described in the explanation in question #13 Remarks.

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#### **ORDINANCE NO. 225**

AN ORDINANCE OF KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, PURSUANT TO <u>IDAHO CODE</u> SECTION 67-6526, ADOPTING A MAP IDENTIFYING THE SPIRIT LAKE AREA OF CITY IMPACT WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>Idaho Code</u> Section 67-6526, the City of Spirit Lake, Idaho, and Kootenai County, Idaho, have conferred and negotiated in good faith upon an Area of City Impact for the City of Spirit Lake within the unincorporated area of Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, a joint public hearing, pursuant to public notice as required by law, was held by the Spirit Lake City Council and the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners on March 20, 1995, on the Map identifying an Area of City Impact; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spirit Lake and Kootenai County, in accordance with the procedure required by law, have mutually agreed upon a Map identifying an Area of City Impact, as Area 1, and a Watershed Notification Area, as Area 2, for the City of Spirit Lake within the unincorporated area of Kootenai County, Idaho;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Kootenai County, Idaho:

#### Section 1

That Area of City Impact and Watershed Notification Area, known as Areas 1 and 2, respectively, within the unincorporated area of Kootenai County are particularly described in Section 2 below, and also set forth on the Map set forth in said Section 2, which Map shall be in effect until amended or modified as allowed by law.

#### Section 2

A legal description for the exterior boundary of the Area of City Impact, Area 1, for the City of Spirit Lake, Idaho:

BEGINNING at the northeast corner of Section 4, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, Boise Meridian;

THENCE, west along the north line of Sections 4, 5, and 6, to the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, south along the west line of Sections 6, 7, and 18, to the southwest comer of Section 18, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, east along the south line of Sections 18, 17, and 16, to the southeast corner of Section 16, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, north along the east line of Sections 16, 9, and 4, to the northeast corner of Section 4, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M., the point of beginning.

A legal description for the exterior boundary of the Watershed Notification Area, Area 2, for the City of Spirit Lake, Idaho:

BEGINNING at the northeast corner of Section 1, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, Boise Meridian;

THENCE, west along the north line of said Section 1 and Section 2, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M., to a point that is the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of said Section 2;

THENCE, south along the west line of the northeast quarter of Section 2 to the

southwest comer of said quarter section;

THENCE, west along the half section line of Sections 2, 3, and 4, to the northwest corner of the south 1/2 of Section 4, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M.;

THENCE, south along the west line of said half section, to the northeast comer of Section 8, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M.;

THENCE, west along the north line of Section 8, to the northwest comer of said section:

THENCE, south along the west line of Sections 8, 17, 20, and 29, to the half section line of Section 29, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M.;

THENCE, east along the half section line of Sections 29, 28, 27, and 26, to the southeast corner of the north 1/2 of Section 26, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M.;

THENCE, north along the east line of Section 26, to the southwest corner of Section 24, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M.;

THENCE, east along the south line of Sections 24 and 19, to the southeast corner of Section 19, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;


THENCE, north along the east line of Section 19, to the southwest corner of the north 1/2 of Section 20, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, east along the south line of the half section to the southeast corner of said half section;

THENCE, north along the east line of Section 20, to the northeast corner of Section 20, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, west along the north line of Sections 20 and 19, to the northwest corner of Section 19, Township 53 North, Range 4 West, B.M.;

THENCE, north along the east line of Sections 13, 12, and 1, to the northeast corner of Section 1, Township 53 North, Range 5 West, B.M., the point of beginning.



#### Section 3

This Map is adopted in conjunction with Ordinance No. 226, and is intended to be an integral part of said Ordinance.

#### Section 4

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word, or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity, or unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of this Ordinance or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word, or part had not been included therein, and if such person or circumstance to which the Ordinance or part thereof is held inapplicable had been specifically exempt therefrom.

#### Section 5

Neither the adoption of this Ordinance nor the repeal of any Ordinance shall, in any manner, affect the prosecution for violation of such Ordinance committed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance or be construed as a waiver of any license or penalty due under any such Ordinance or in any manner affect the validity of any action heretofore taken by Board of County Commissioners of Kootenai County, Idaho, or the validity of any such action to be taken upon matters pending before the Board of County Commissioners on the effective date of this Ordinance.

#### Section 6

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### Section 7

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the <u>Coeur d'Alene Press</u>, a newspaper of general circulation within Kootenai County, Idaho.



### WATER RIGHT SALE

FROM: SPIRIT LAKE LAND COMPANY

TO: THE CITY OF SPIRIT LAKE

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH:

That the SPIRIT LAKE LAND COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to it in hand paid by the CITY OF SPIRIT LAKE, a municipal corpor tion of Kootenai County, Idaho, party of the second part, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part all that real estate situated in Kootenai County, State of Idaho, described as follows; to-wit:

That certain water right to the amount of ten second feet, taken out of the waters of Spirit Lake, in the County of Kootenai, State of Idaho, at point of diversion on Lot 9, Section 7, Township 53 N. Range 4 W. B. M., as such water right is measured and defined by the Commissioner of Reclamation of Idaho by water license and certificate No. 9693 dated December 27, 1920.

to have and to hold all and singular the above bargained and described water right together with the appurtenances unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said party of the first part has caused this instrument to be executed by its duly authorized officers and its corporate seal to be affixed this 27 day of May, 1941.

# Brief History for the City of Spirit Lake Water System.

The City of Spirit Lake Water system was originally constructed by the Spirit Lake Land Company beginning in 1907. The Spirit Lake Land Company constructed a dam across the outlet of Spirit Lake to back up water and create a reservoir. A diversion and distribution system consisting of a pumphouse, lake water intake piping, multiple high capacity pumps, 100,000 gallon water tank, and a network of approximately 38,000 lineal feet of distribution piping ranging in size from 2-inch to 12-inches in diameter. The original water works withdrew water from Spirit Lake and distributed the water to the City for Municipal, Domestic, Industrial, Commercial, Fire Protection, and Irrigation uses. There were originally 349 service connections. The original water right, No. 9693 (currently updated to numbers 95-9677 and 95-9678) was perfected in 1920 with a priority date of October 2, 1913. The original water right claimed a 10 cubic feet per second (cfs) diversion plus an additional 15 cfs diversion for future development for a total of 25 cfs. Proof of beneficial use included construction of the entire water system including water lines, water tank, pumping facilities and dam. The Spirit Lake Land Company sold the water right, No. 9693 to the City of Spirit Lake in 1941.

According to the IDWR historic documents, the City of Spirit Lake residents were served water via this water right between the years of 1907 and 1963. In 1963 the lake water was deemed contaminated, and water for the City's municipal use was subsequently supplied by groundwater wells. After that time the lake water pump station was inactive; however, the distribution system and 100,000 gallon water reservoir continued in operation. The 100,000 gallon water reservoir was constructed in 1921 and is still in use today. This reservoir was rehabilitated and repainted in 2005, and it is anticipated that it will continue in use for an additional 50+ years. Throughout the City the existing steel and wooden water mainlines have been replaced and updated as they have reached their life expectancy. These updated water lines are located in the same streets and in the same locations as the original water lines. Today the same lots that received water from the original system are still receiving water via the same distribution network and storage system.

The place and type of use today is consistent with the original water system installed prior to 1920. The original intent for this water right was to provide water service to the City of Spirit Lake. The City of Spirit Lake is asserting a claim to this water right through proof of the 1941 sales agreement and deed, and through consistency in the intent and type of use today as it has been for over 100 years.
