HOW YOU WILL RECEIVE NOTICE IN THE SNAKE RIVER BASIN ADJUDICATION

Updated for Deferred *De Minimis* Domestic and/or Stockwater Claims

All deferred *de minimis* domestic and/or stockwater claim documents filed in the Snake River Basin Adjudication (SRBA) are filed with the court. Copies of documents should be sent to the State of Idaho, the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) and the United States. Copies of all documents filed in the SRBA will not be mailed to all parties (claimants) in the adjudication. Any document filed with the court will be mailed only to those parties who may be directly affected by it.

The court prepares a monthly docket sheet, a summary of all documents filed with the court in the previous month and the dates and locations of hearings scheduled for the following three months. The docket sheet will be filed with the district court clerk in each county within the SRBA. Copies of a monthly docket sheet are available at all IDWR offices; a small fee may be charged to cover the cost of mailing and/or copying. If you wish to receive a printed docket sheet each month, you should mark the appropriate place on your notice of claim form. You will be charged a small annual subscription fee by the court to cover the cost of copying and mailing. The docket sheet is also available on the court's website: srba.state.id.us/docket.htm. Copies of any document listed on the docket sheet are available at all IDWR offices and the court; a small fee may be charged to cover the cost of mailing and/or copying.

Copies of all filed notices of claim are available at all IDWR offices. You may also obtain copies of notices of claim filed by others, but you may be charged the cost of copying/ mailing. A claimant will not be charged for a copy of his/her own notice of claim. A person who acquires property with water rights for which a notice of claim was filed will not be charged for a copy of the notice of claim filed by the previous owner.

After reviewing a claimant's notice(s) of claim, the director will prepare and file a Director's Report with the court that will contain the Director's recommendations as to each water right claimed under state law. When IDWR files the Director's Report which includes your water right(s) with the court, IDWR will send a copy of the Director's Report and a notice of filing to you at the most recent address in IDWR's files. If you do not agree with the way your water right is described, you may file an objection to the report with the court. You can also file an objection if you disagree with the way another claimant's water rights are described. The notice of filing will tell you when and where to file your objection.

It is important that you inform IDWR in writing of any change in your address, ensuring that you receive notices affecting your water rights that are to be mailed by IDWR or the court.

If you acquire property with water rights within the Snake River Basin water system in Idaho (either by purchase, gift, inheritance, or other means), it is important that you inquire of IDWR whether a notice of claim for deferred *de minimis* domestic or stockwater use has been filed. If a notice of claim has been filed, it is important that you file a written notice of change in ownership with IDWR. You may contact an IDWR regional offices or visit the IDWR website www.idwr.idaho.gov for change of ownership forms. The notice of change in ownership form must be accompanied by evidence of the ownership of the property. Again, this is to make sure that you receive the notices affecting your water rights that are to be mailed by IDWR or the court.

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Blackfoot, Idaho,** has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of **Albin Lindstrom** east half of the southeast quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section thirty-one and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section thirty-two in Township four south of Range forty-four east of the Boise Meridian, Idaho, containing one hundred sixty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
