) **MOTION TO RESET SCHEDULE**

1. On October 21, 2025, the United States moved to stay proceedings ("Motion") regarding commencement of the Kootenai River Basin Adjudication ("KRBA") during the pendency of the lapse in federal appropriations.

2. On October 22, 2025, the Court granted the Motion and vacated the scheduled dates for briefing and a hearing on the commencement of the KRBA pending the restoration of appropriations.

3. On November 21, 2025, the United States filed a notice of restoration of appropriations and indicated that the parties were in discussions regarding a modified schedule which would account for delays while counsel for the United States was furloughed.

4. The United States proposes that the following schedule be entered:

- **February 13**: Any response in opposition to the State's Petition shall be filed.
- **February 20**: Any reply in support of the State's Petition shall be.
- **February 24** (or thereafter, deferring to the Court's availability): Commencement hearing on the State's petition.

5. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the State, Department of Water Resources, and Kootenai Tribe, and this motion is unopposed.

6. For the foregoing reasons, the United States respectfully requests that the Court enter the schedule described above for further proceedings.
