CONTINUANCE OF HEARING ON
UNCONTESTED WATER RIGHTS IN
BASIN 97, PART 1 DIRECTOR'S
REPORT**

On December 17, 2024, the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed a Director's Report for Basin 97 Part 1. A hearing on the uncontested water rights in that Director's Report is set for January 20, 2026.

On December 30, 2025, the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed a motion to continue the January 20, 2026, hearing until June 2026. The Department asserts it is in the interest of judicial efficiency and economy to hold the hearing on the uncontested water rights after the initial hearings have been held for the Basin 97, Part I Director's Report. Although dates for those initial hearings have not yet been set, the initial hearings are anticipated to be held sometime in April 2026. The reason stated for holding the hearing on the uncontested rights after the initial hearings is that during initial hearings it is possible that an uncontested water right may be identified as an overlap to a contested water right. The Court in an exercise of its discretion will grant the motion.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion for Continuance of Hearing on Uncontested Water Rights in Basin 97, Part 1 Director's Report is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing on the uncontested water rights set for January 20, 2026, is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing on the uncontested water rights in the Basin 97, Part 1 Director's Report is reset to be held on June 16, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. (Pacific Time) at the Snake River Basin Adjudication Courthouse, 253 – 3rd Avenue North, Twin Falls,

Idaho. This hearing will be conducted using the ZOOM remote hearing application. Instructions for Zoom are attached to this Order.

- If joining only by telephone, press *6 to toggle between unmute/mute.
