A *Motion to Withdraw as Counsel* was filed by Susan Wilson on March 3, 2026. A hearing on the *Motion* was held on March 11, 2026.

Ms. Wilson explained that she represented the claimant Jo Dean Moore and also the Estate of Jo Dean Moore. The estate is now closed, and the subsequent owners of the real property have not filed changes of ownership with the Idaho Department of Water Resources. At the hearing, IDWR explained that it has researched ownership records and sent a letter to the potential new property owners. It will file a *Notice of Completed Administrative Procedure* to update the ownership and claimant information when possible. Because Ms. Wilson is no longer associated with the claimant, she seeks to withdraw from this subcase.

The Court finds good cause for counsel to withdraw. In addition, the Court finds that withdrawal will not create delays or prejudice to any parties.

There was no opposition to the *Motion*, and the Court **granted** the *Motion to Withdraw*. Therefore, Ms. Wilson and her firm no longer represent the claimant in this subcase.

Pursuant to Idaho Rule of Civil Procedure 11.3 (c)(1), IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Ms. Wilson and her firm are permitted to withdraw as counsel of record for Jo Dean Moore.
- 2) Pursuant to IRCP 11.3 (c)(1), the claimant is **required to either appoint another attorney to appear on their behalf in this subcase or file notice with the Court that they will represent themselves in this subcase. This action must be done within 21 days after the claimant is served with this Order.**

- 3) Pursuant to IRCP 11.3 (c)(1), **if the claimant fails to file and serve a written appearance explaining how they will proceed within this 21-day period, such failure may be sufficient grounds for dismissing the *Claim*.**
- 4) Ms. Wilson shall serve copies of this order on the claimant and shall file proof of service with this Court.
