

United States' Motion to Participate in Specified CFRBA Subcases

On January 15, 2025, the United States of America, as Trustee on Behalf of the Kalispel Tribe of Indians of the Kalispel Indian Reservation Acting Through the Northwest Regional Director, filed forty-five water right claims within the CFRBA. *See Attach. A, Column 1.* On January 16, 2025, the Kalispel Tribe of Indians, Acting Through the Kalispel Business, filed three water right claims within the CFRBA. *See Attach. A, Column 2.* All forty-eight of these claims were included in the Idaho Department of Water Resources' Notice of Filing of Director's Report of Federal Reserved Water Right Claims in Basins 96 and 97 of the CFRBA.

Pursuant to the CFPRBA Administrative Order 1, Section 11(i),¹ and Idaho Rules of Civil Procedure 7 and 24, the United States of America, on behalf of the U.S. Department of Defense, Army Corps of Engineers ("USACE"), hereby files this motion to participate in the forty-eight subcases involving the water rights claimed and listed in Attachment A, expressly for the purpose of reserving the right to take part in negotiations and/or litigation concerning such claims to the extent the water rights to be decreed may interact with the interests of USACE. The United States represents many different interests in the western water adjudications. Here, U.S. Department of Justice attorneys in the Tribal Resources Section of the Environment and Natural Resources Division filed the forty-five claims on behalf of the Kalispel Tribe of Indians. However, USACE is represented in the CFPRBA adjudication by U.S. Department of Justice attorneys in the Natural Resources Section of the Environment and Natural Resources Division. Participation by USACE and its counsel in these CFPRBA subcases is necessary to ensure that the interests of USACE are represented and considered in any final decrees issued. This motion to participate is timely and will not prejudice other parties in these subcases because, procedurally, the motion is being filed before applicable deadlines for objections and responses have even occurred.

Pursuant to Idaho Rule of Civil Procedure 7(b)(3)(D), the United States notes that it does not intend to file any further brief or memorandum in support of this motion.
