OTHER PROVISIONS NECESSARY F	OR DEFINITON OR ADMINISTRATION OF	F THIS WATER RIGHT:	

This right is limited to the intermittent diversion and use of water for the stated purposes. This water right shall not be used as a basis to prevent the future appropriation of water or the basis to request or initiate a delivery call or otherwise have the Idaho Department of Water Resources, a Water District or a Court curtail or limit distribution in whole or in part, to existing legal uses of water to satisfy this water right. This provision shall not be construed as a basis to curtail the United States' use of water under this right to satisfy junior water rights.

This partial decree is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of the water rights as may be ultimately determined by the Court at a point in time no later than entry of a final unified decree. Idaho Code § 42-1412(6).
